Admission

- Registration begins on November 15th for entry in September 2008.
- Malaspina advisors recommend that you apply on-line at www.mala.ca/apply.asp, or www.mybccampus.ca
- Ask Careers Centre staff to deliver your completed application, in a sealed envelope addressed to Malaspina Admissions with a cheque for \$30 non-refundable admission fee enclosed, on November 16th.
- If you want to apply to more than one program you must apply to each program separately, but only pay the \$30 application fee once.
- The application deadline is March 31st unless otherwise indicated by a particular program.

Admission

- Students can apply for admission at Simon Fraser starting November 1st.
- Look for admission requirements at <http://students.sfu.ca/adm/bcsec.html>
- Apply on-line at <http://students.sfu.ca> which will link you to www.mybccampus.ca
- Use the ID and password received when you applied on-line and log into <http://gosfu.ca> to pay your application fees by credit card.
- The deadline is February 28th.

Housing

- All out-of-town students are guaranteed residence for fall 2008 provided they apply to SFU by the February 28th deadline. Housing deadline is March 31st for a guaranteed spot.

Entrance Scholarships

- SFU guarantees an entrance scholarship with a minimum value of \$3,500 for applicants with 90% and above and \$5,000 for 95% and above.
- Applications for entrance scholarships are due on February 28th.

Admission

- Applications open on-line in October at <http://students.ubc.ca/welcome/apply.cfm>
- UBC strongly encourages students to apply early and will consider applicants for admission as soon as they submit the necessary documents for evaluation.
- The deadline for applications is February 28th.

Housing

- It is important to apply for housing at the same time you apply for admission, or by Feb. 1st. Go to www.students.ubc.ca/welcome/housing.cfm for an application.
- UBC gives priority to applicants who live outside the Lower Mainland and last year were able to accommodate all first-year students who applied.
- First-year students typically live at Place Vanier or Totem Park residences.

Entrance Scholarships

- Candidates for major entrance scholarships are nominated by their schools and evaluated on a competitive basis. Dover Bay will nominate 6 candidates based on the criteria of outstanding academics and leadership.
- UBC's application deadline is February 28th.
- Watch for Dover Bay's nomination deadline in early-February.

Automatic Entrance Awards

Applicants with admission averages (on final grades) at 86% qualify for a \$500 book award; at 90% qualify for a \$2,000 scholarship and at 95% a \$4,000 scholarship.

Entrance Scholarships

- Application deadline for UVic Entrance Scholarships is February 28, 2008.
- Applications will be available online at www.uvic.ca/safa in December, 2007.
- Minimum academic requirements for consideration is a 90% or higher average on the grade 11/12 courses required for admission to the faculty or program applied for. To see a list of program requirements, go to www.uvic.ca/adms
