Project Display Checklist

Students should start planning their display as soon as they start their project. The following is a list of some of the items that should be included on the display board:

Display Board:

The display board should tri-fold (should stand on a table top on its own). Tri-fold boards can be purchased at office or arts and craft stores or can be made using a large size cardboard box.

If a cardboard box is used, students may think of covering it with colourful paper.

Work displayed on the board:

The following are some ideas of the type of information needed on the board and different ways of illustrating the process followed.

- Pictures taken or drawings made at different phases of the experiment
- Data notebook or background research notes (put on the table)
- List of equipment and/or material used in the experiment
- A title (as a header at the top of the display board)
- Statement – Question asked
- Hypothesis
- Procedure
- Results
- Conclusion
- Some background information reviewing the scientific phenomena

On the table in front of Tri-fold Board

- Data notebook
- Sample of the final project
- Survey (if needed)
- Any object related to the project useful for a demonstration
